## 1.0 INTRODUCTION

Under special circumstances, St. Joseph's Healthcare Hamilton (SJHH) and Research St. Joseph's – Hamilton (RSJ-H) may make some of its research space and equipment available to commercial enterprises, which have specific, specialized research needs.

## 2.0 PROCEDURES

Commercial enterprises interested in using the specialized research facility shall make written application to the RSJ-H Scientific Director who will review the application with the director of the appropriate research area and President, SJHH. A successful applicant will be required to enter into a contract with SJHH. The contract will clearly identify the following:

- a) Designated space;
- b) The time-lines for the completion of the project;
- c) The types of equipment that will be used;
- d) Insurance responsibility for the respective partners;
- e) Licence agreements;
- f) Intellectual property rights for work carried out in conjunction with SJHH and RSJ-H personnel;
- g) Any other terms that might be necessary given the specialized nature of individual projects, e.g. relating to the use of isotopes etc;
- h) Rental income will be retained by Research St. Joseph's - Hamilton and contribute to annual payment to St. Joseph's Healthcare Hamilton for space and services provided by St. Joseph's Healthcare Hamilton to Research St. Joseph's - Hamilton.

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
