**NK1 Antagonists for Pathological Aggression: A Protocol for Harmful, Impulsive, and Self-
Aggressive Behavior (AHIMSA-1) Trial**



Researchers at St. Joseph's Healthcare Hamilton and UHN-Toronto Western Hospital are conducting a study about how an investigational drug affects performance on aggression tasks and aggression-related psychology testing. This may one day help us to treat anger and aggression more effectively using a medication.

This is a research study. Participants would come for 4 visits. The first visit takes about 3 hours and is an initial screening and magnetic resonance imaging (MRI).

If you are between the ages of 18-65 and have issues with anger and aggression, you may be eligible for participation in the study. Compensation will be provided for eligible participants.
